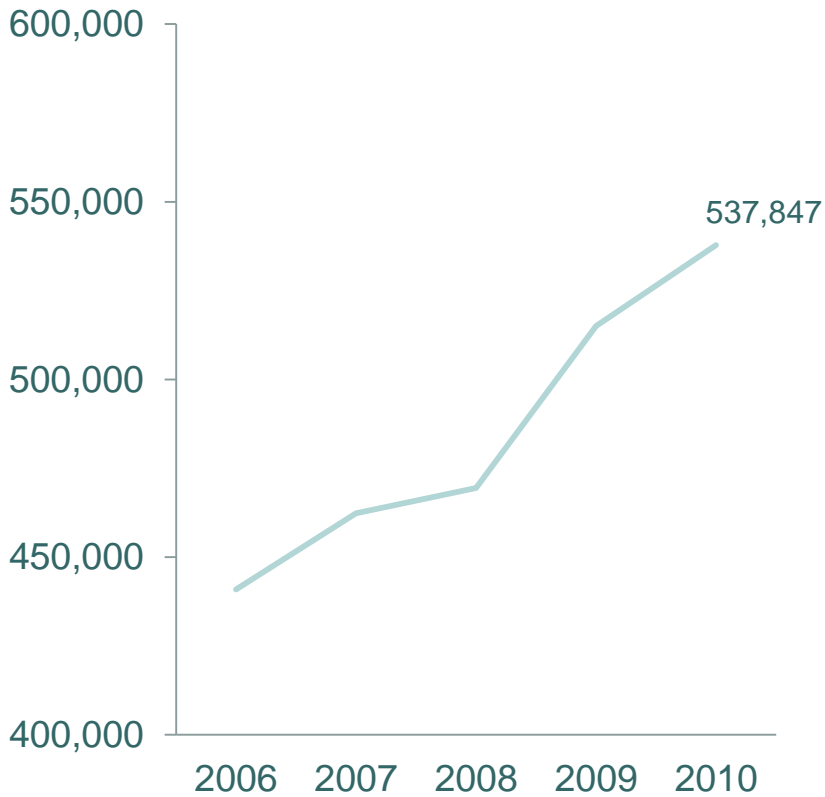


Data Sources

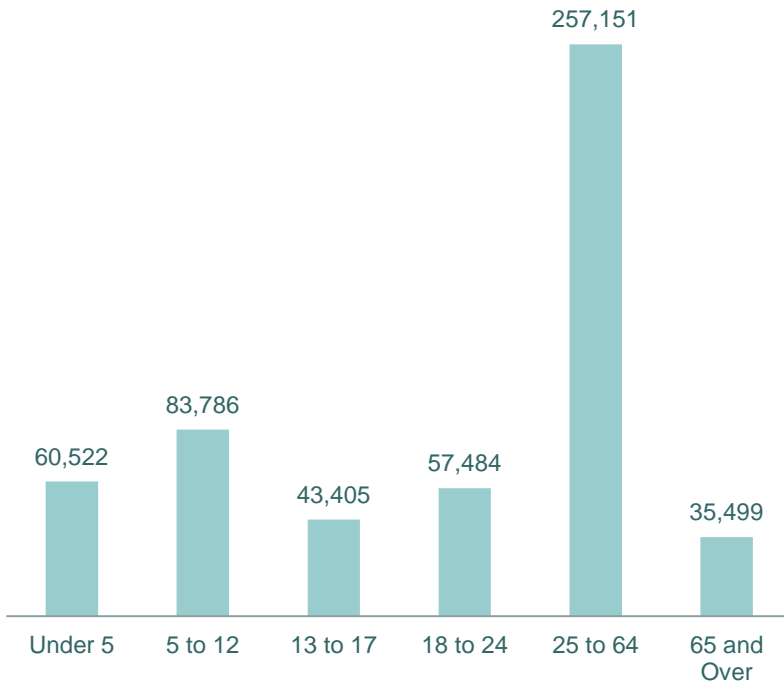

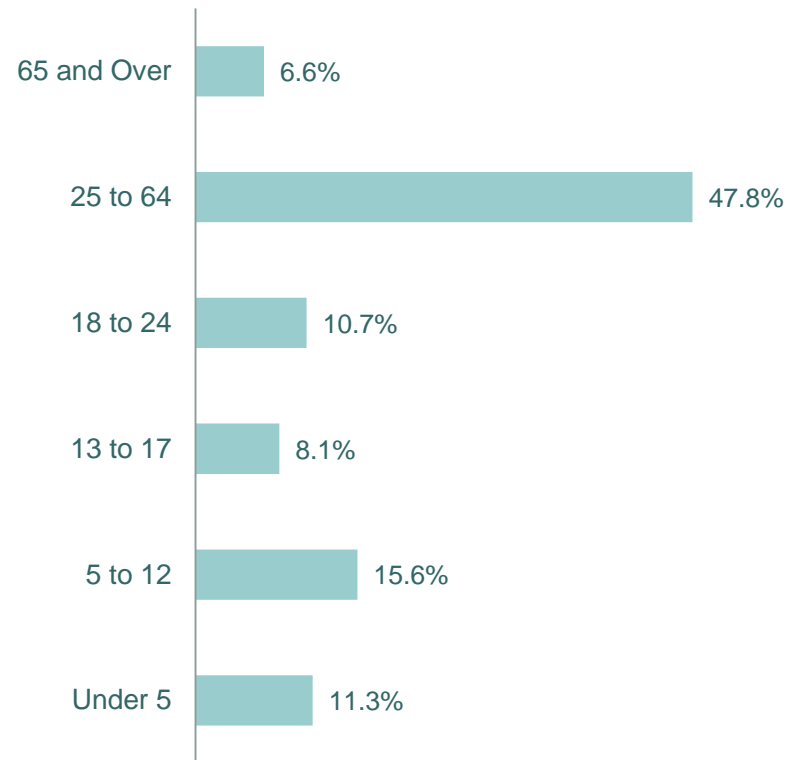

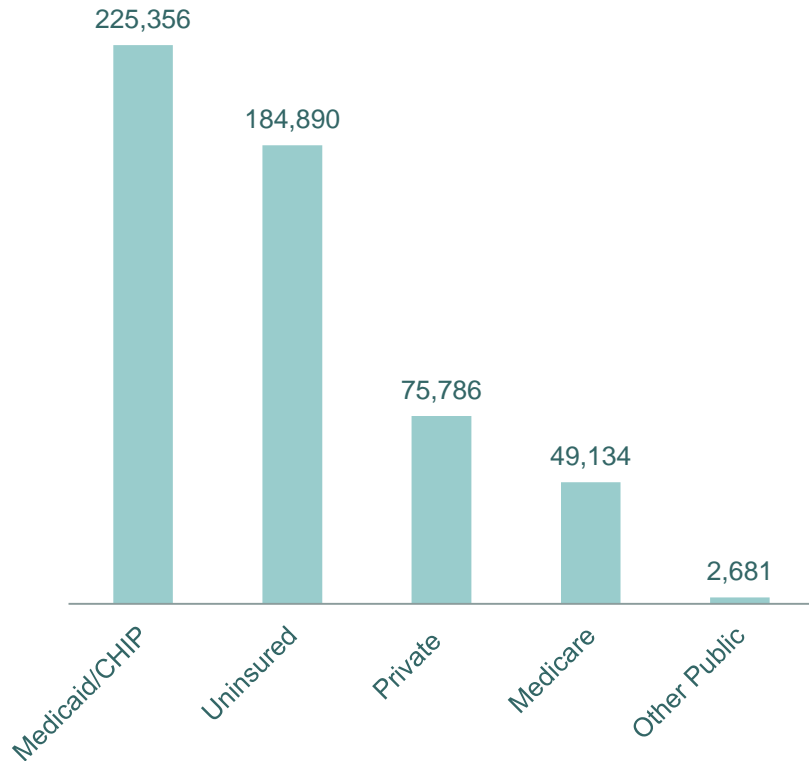

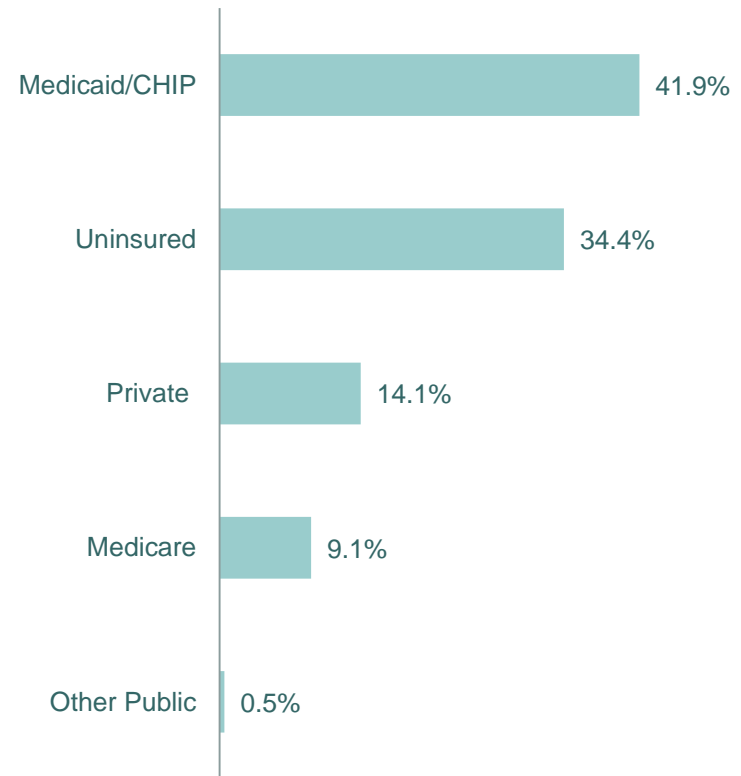


Patients by Insurance Status - Statewide

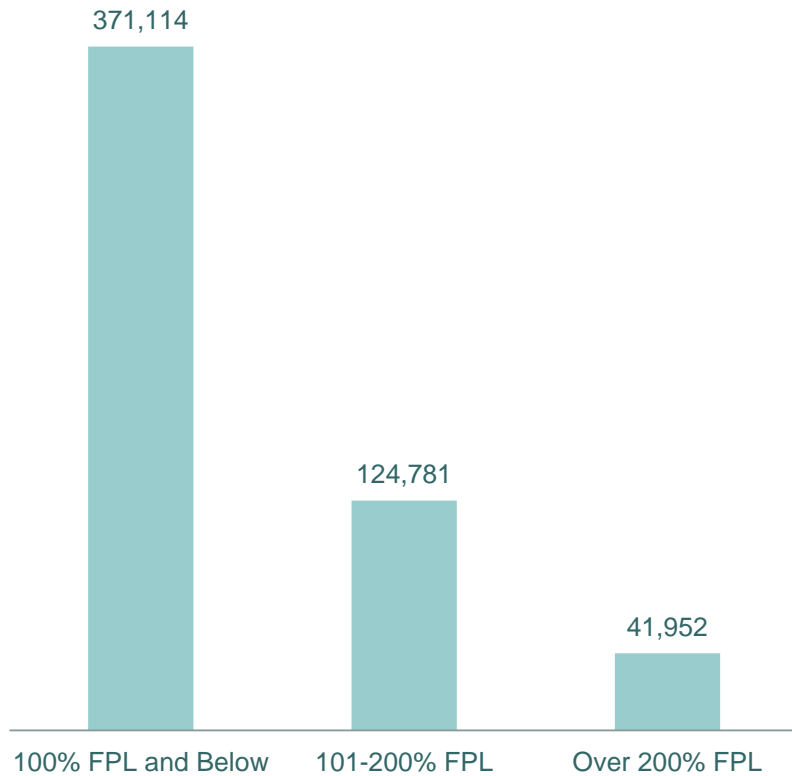

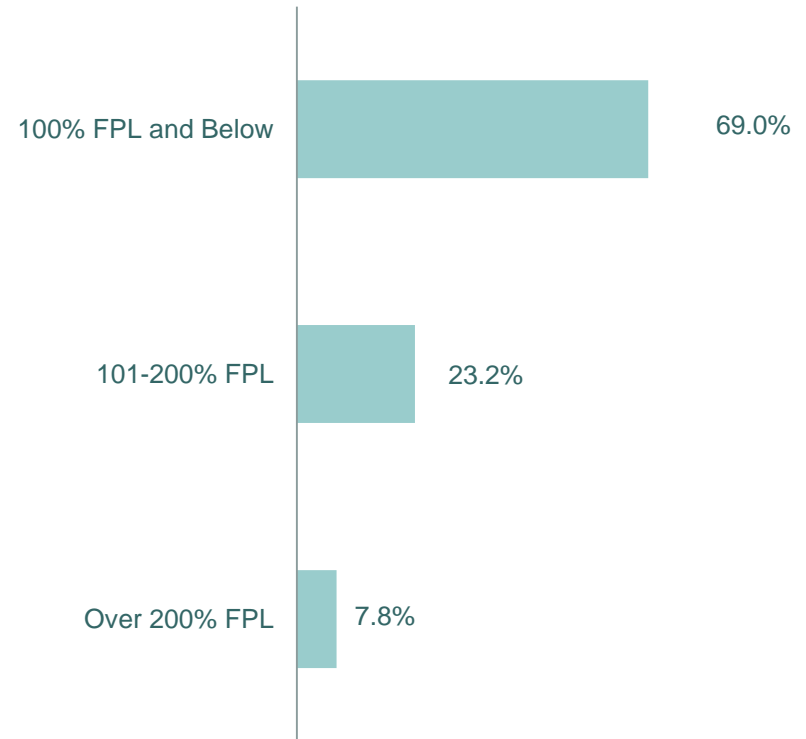


Patients by Income Level - Statewide

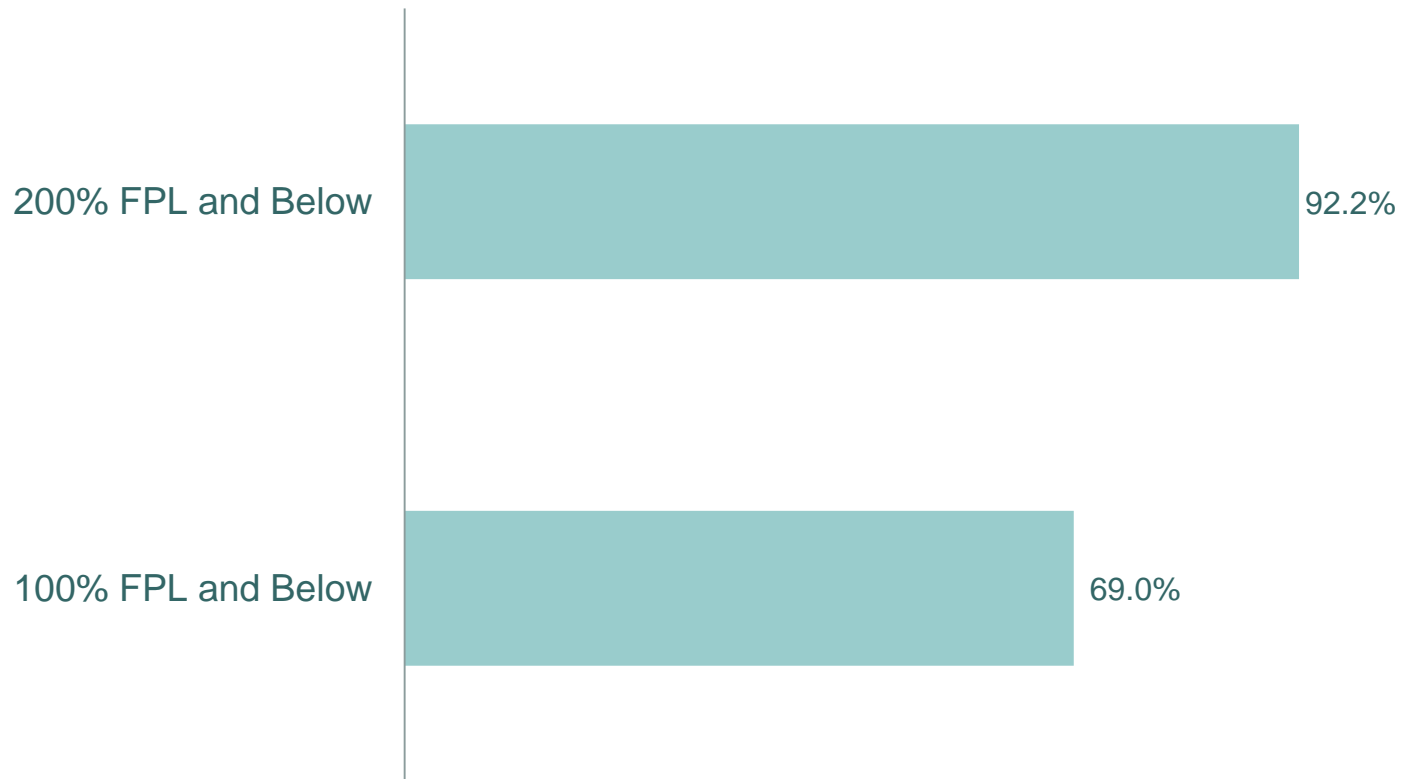

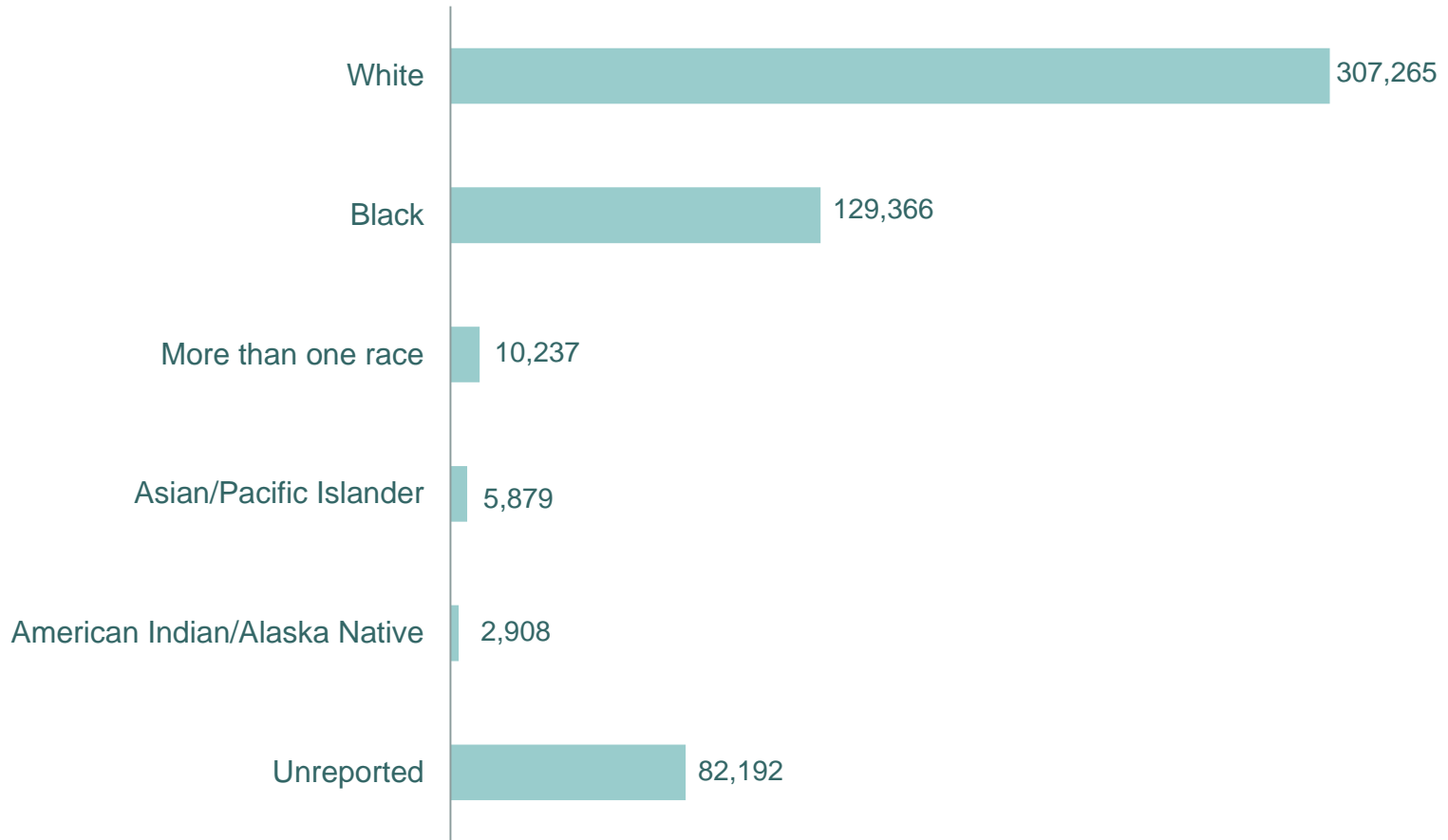


Patients by Income Level - % Below 100% & 200% FPL



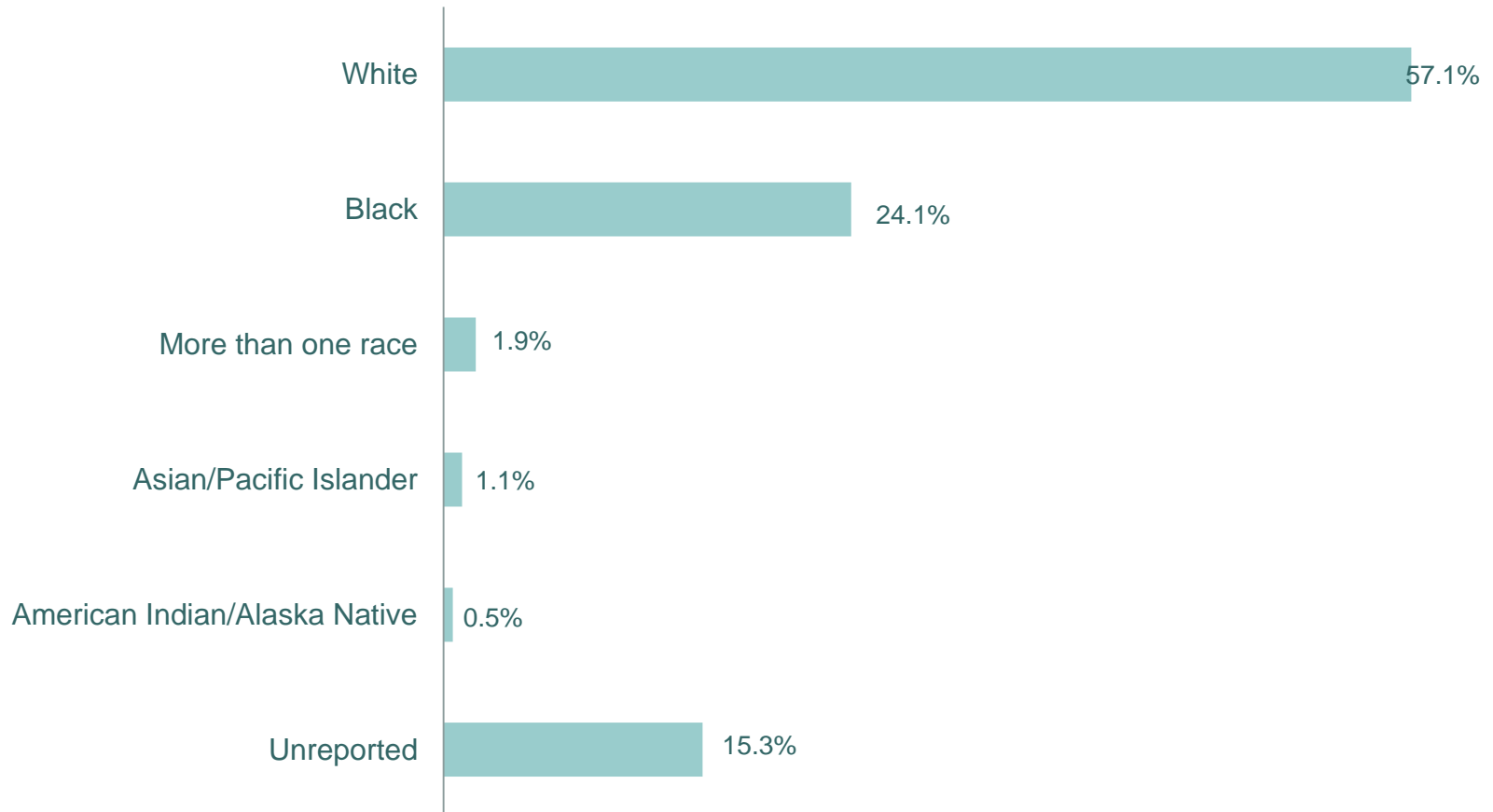


Patients by Race – Statewide (Total)



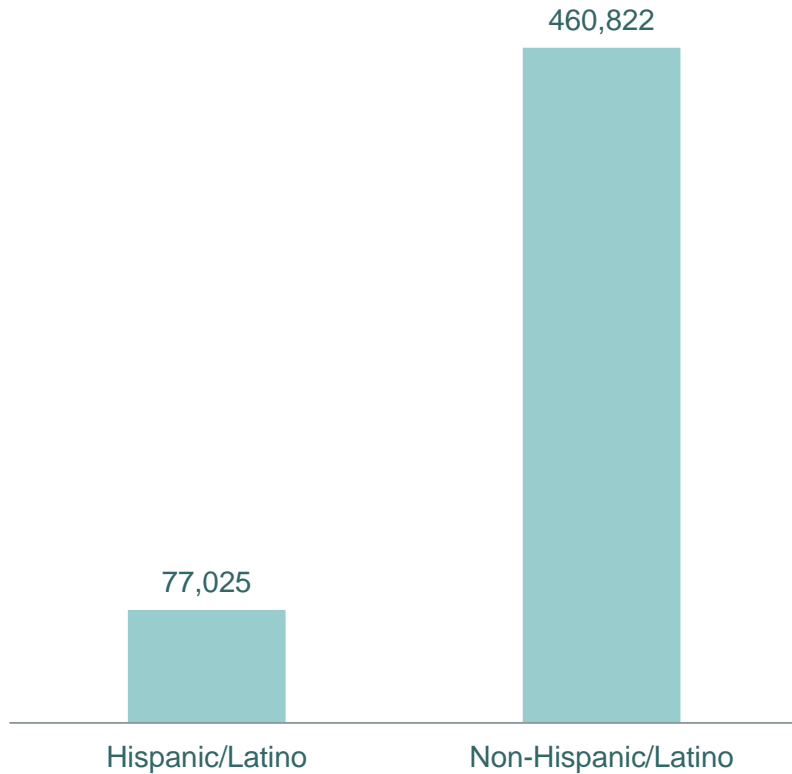


Patients by Race – Statewide (Percentage)

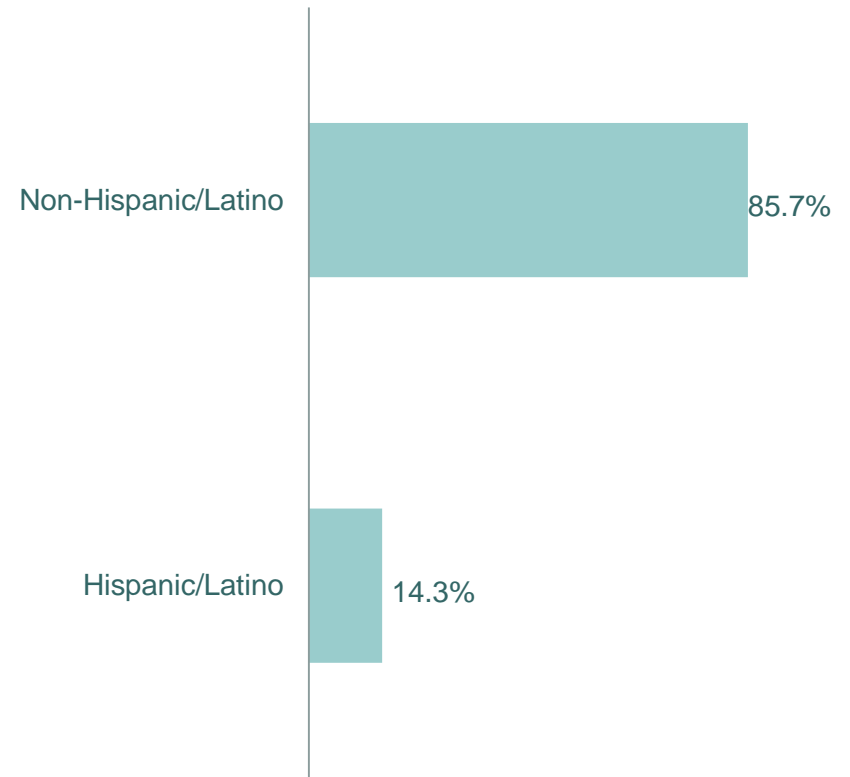

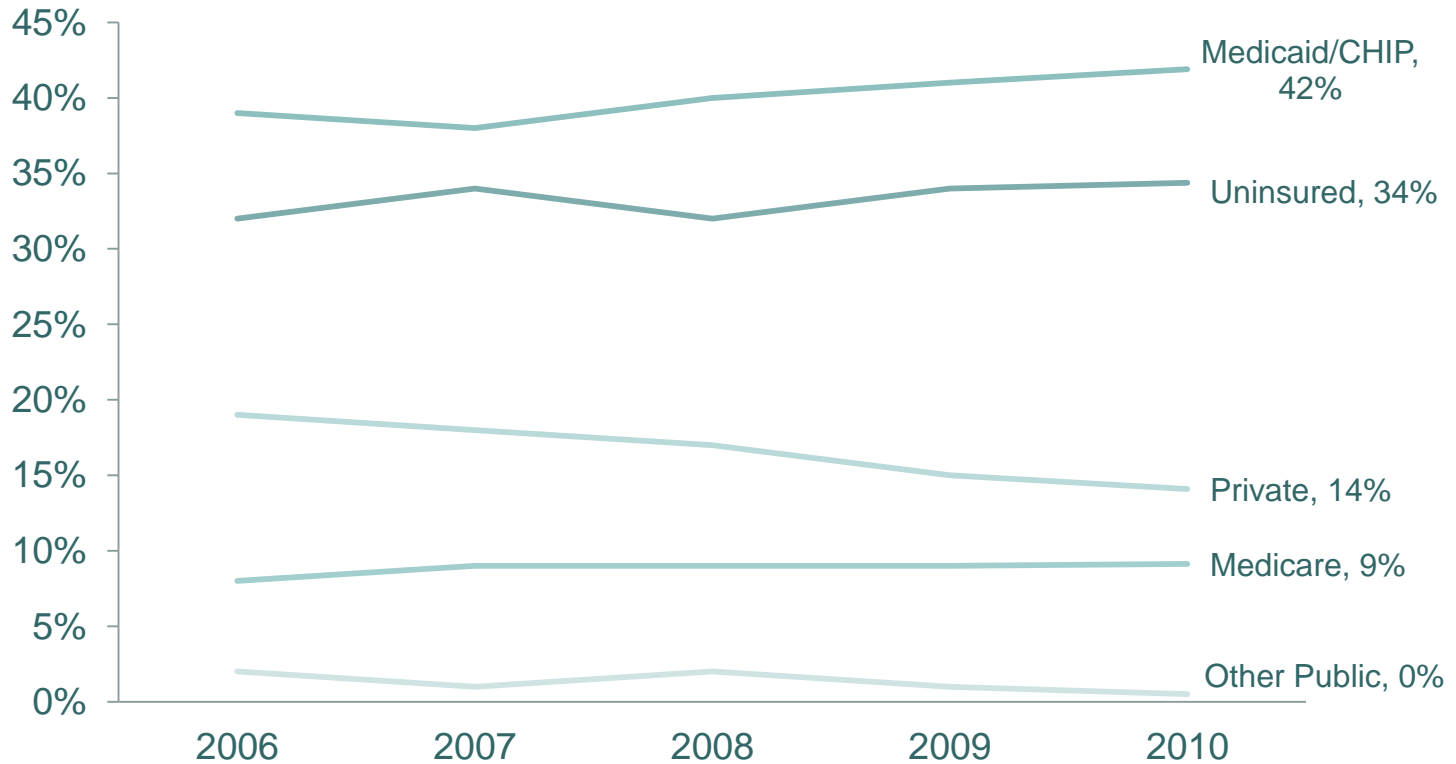




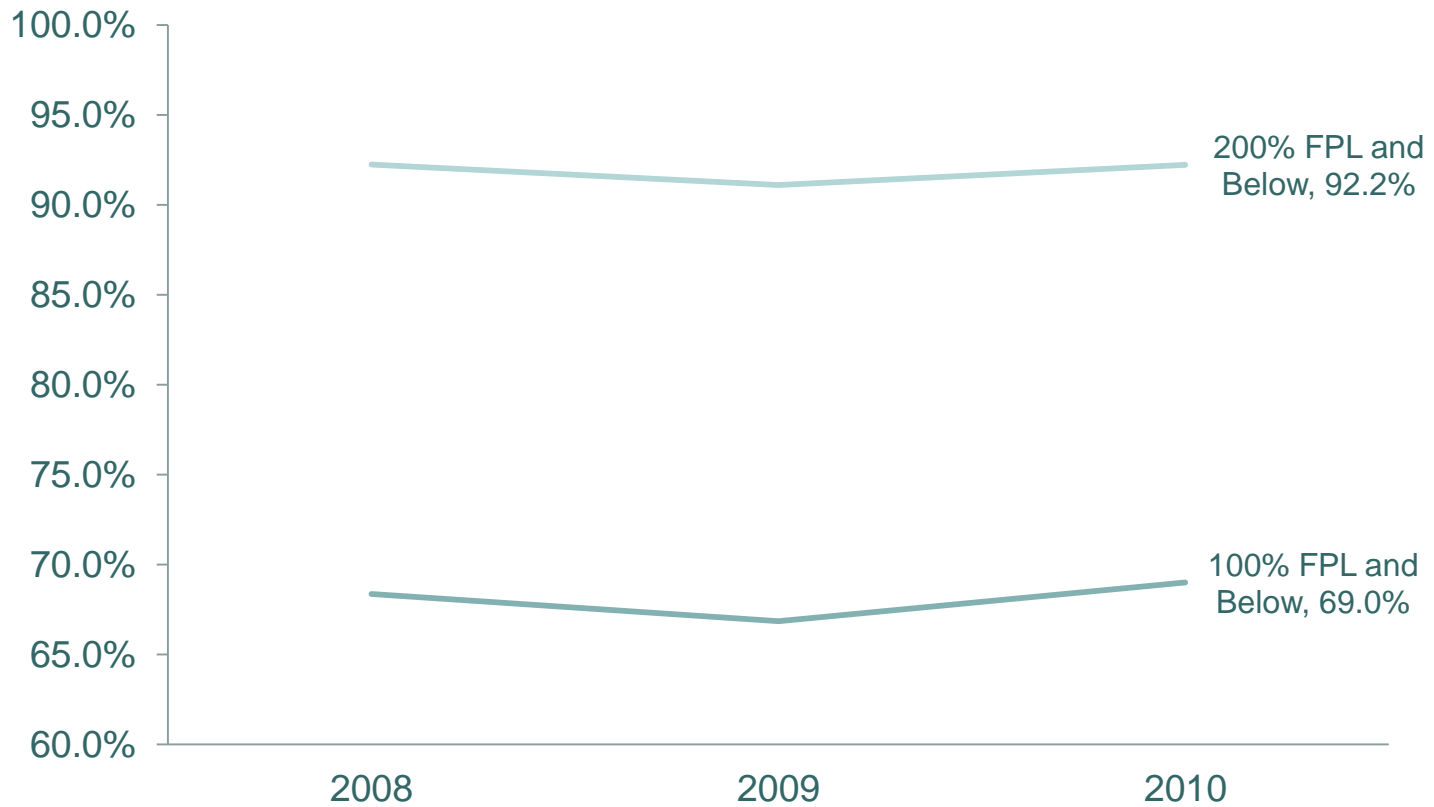

3-Year Statewide Trend for Income Level



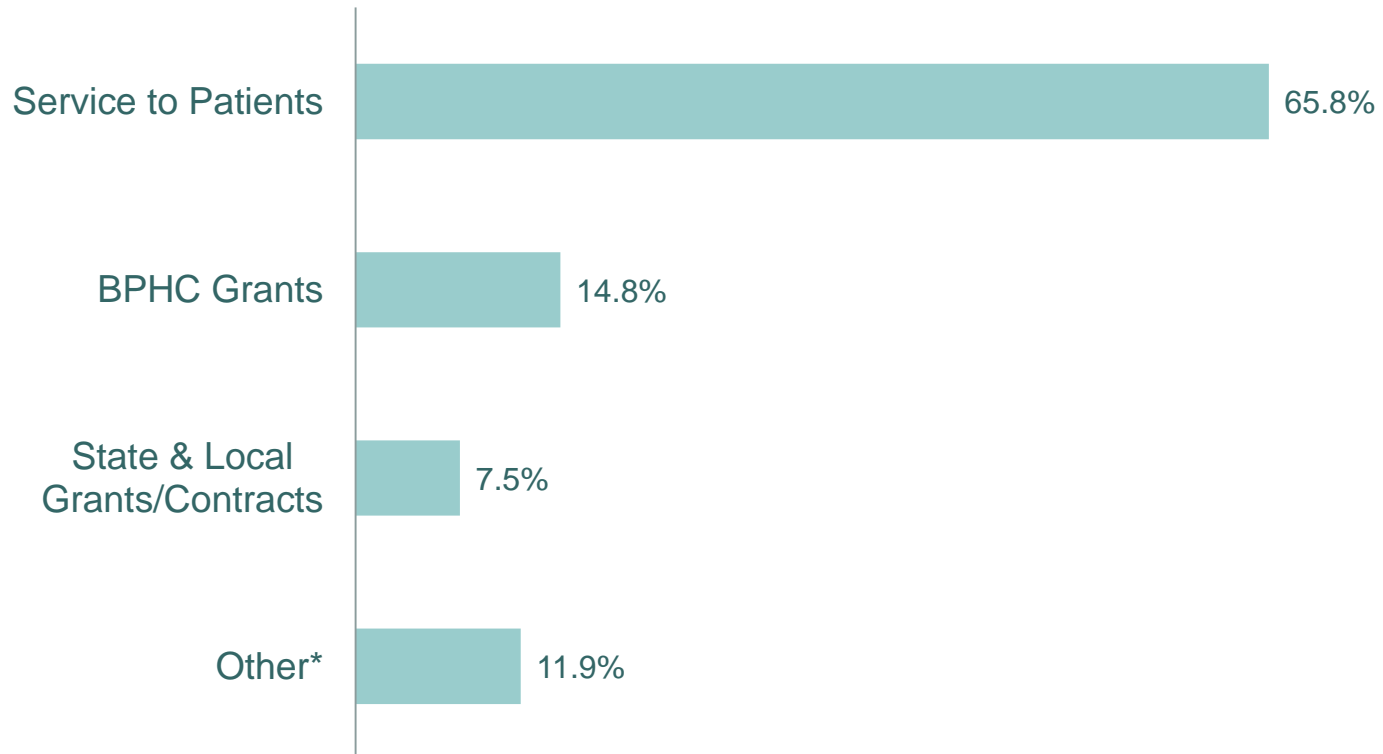

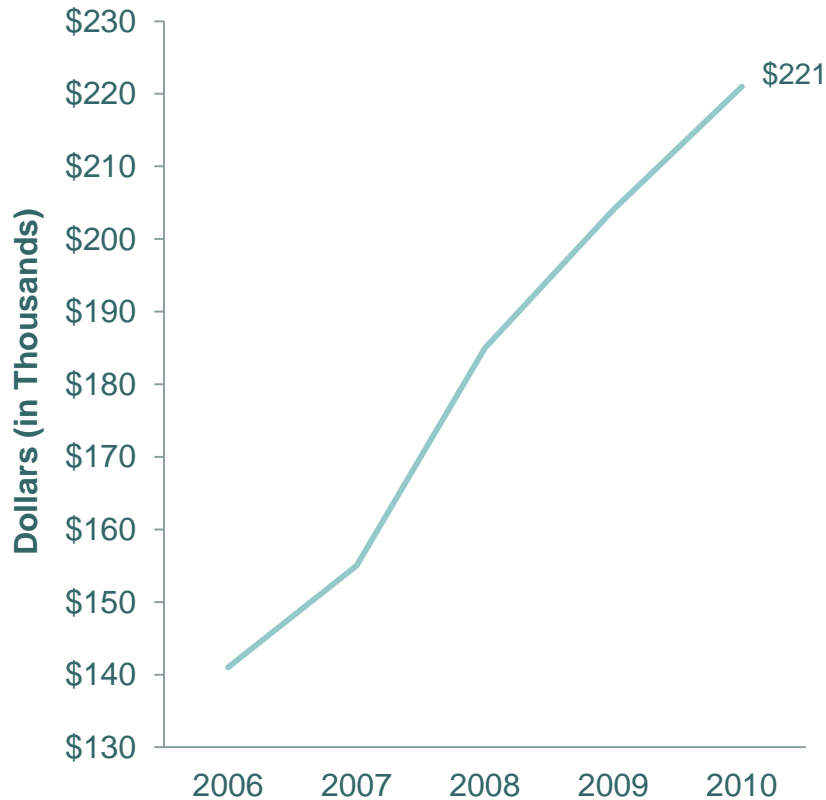
Revenue Distribution (Percent of Total)

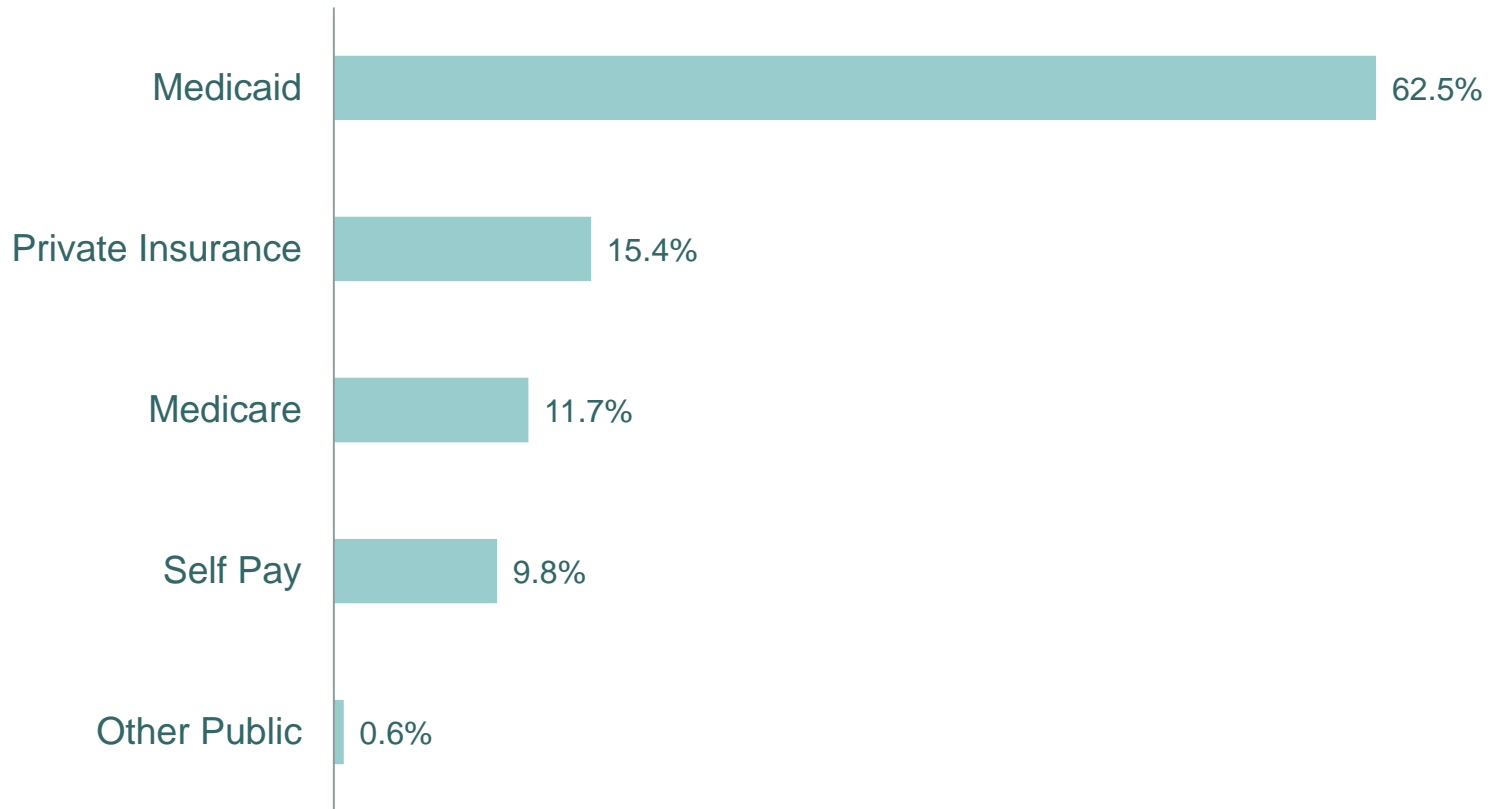


Percent Change from Prior Year



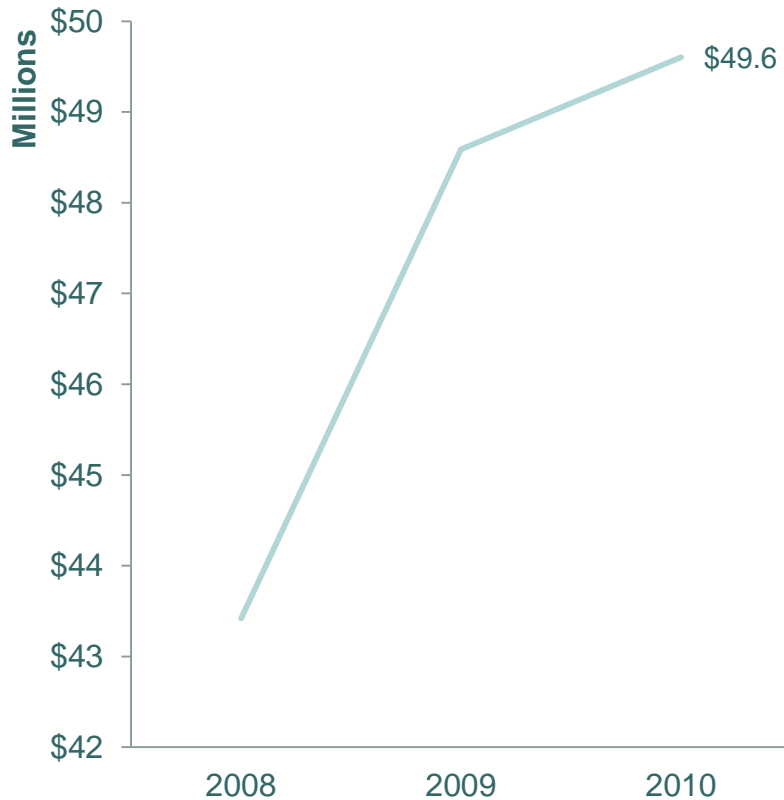


Amount Collected by Payor (Percent of Total)

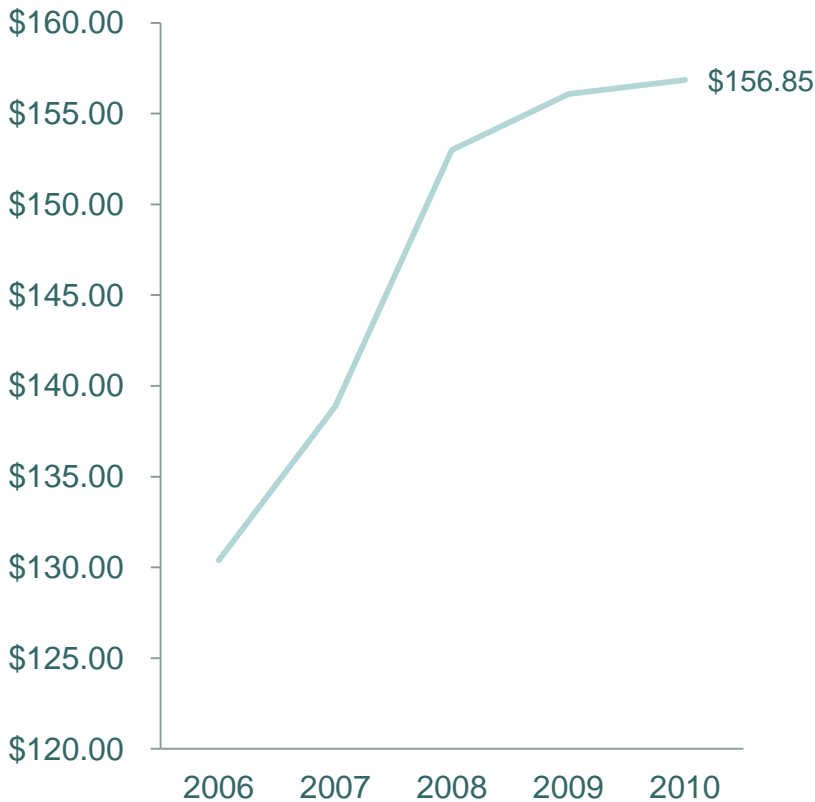


Percent Change from Prior Year

5-Year Trend for Prenatal Care in 1st Trimester

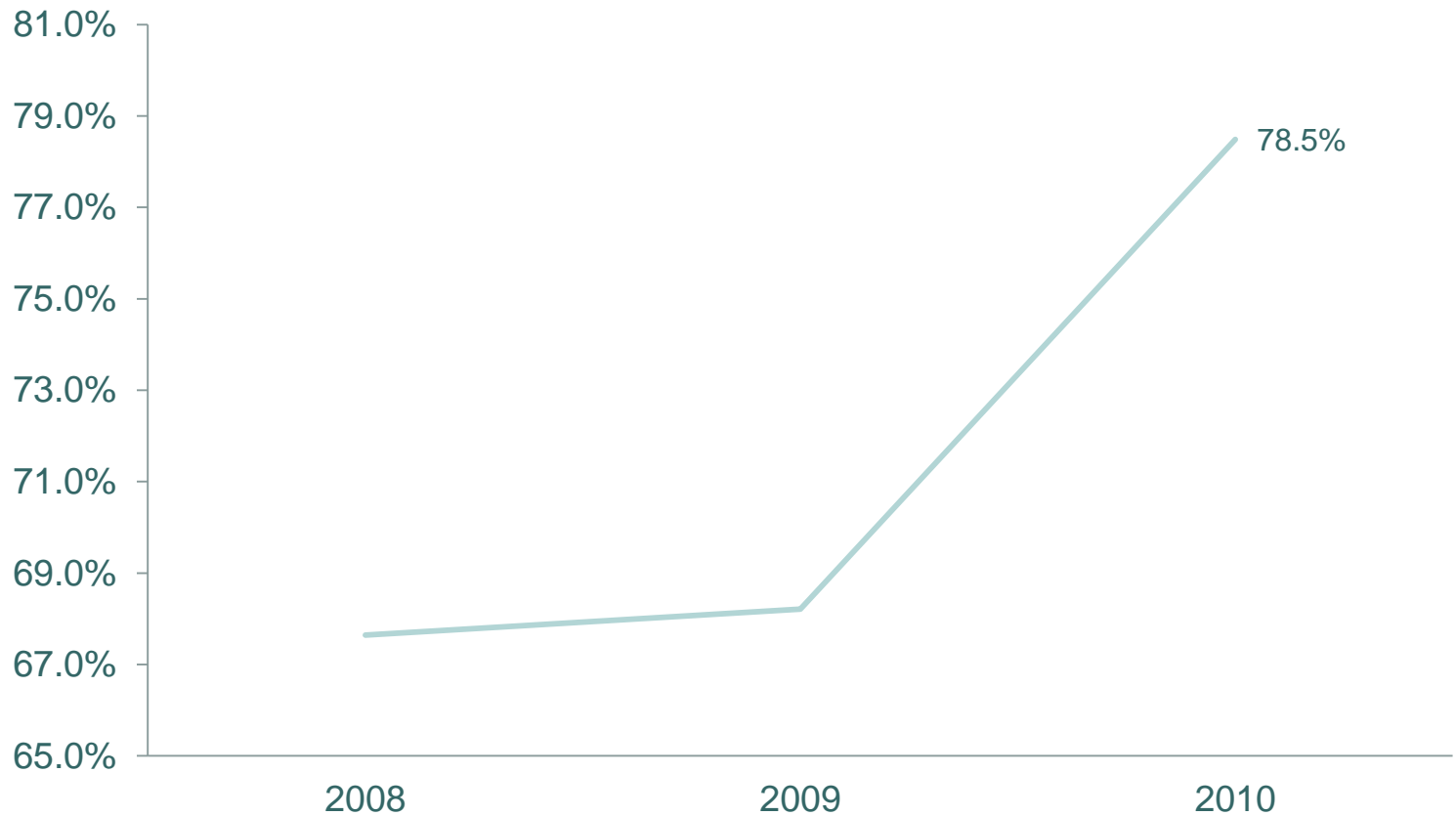


5-Year Trend for Low Birth Weight (<2500 grams)



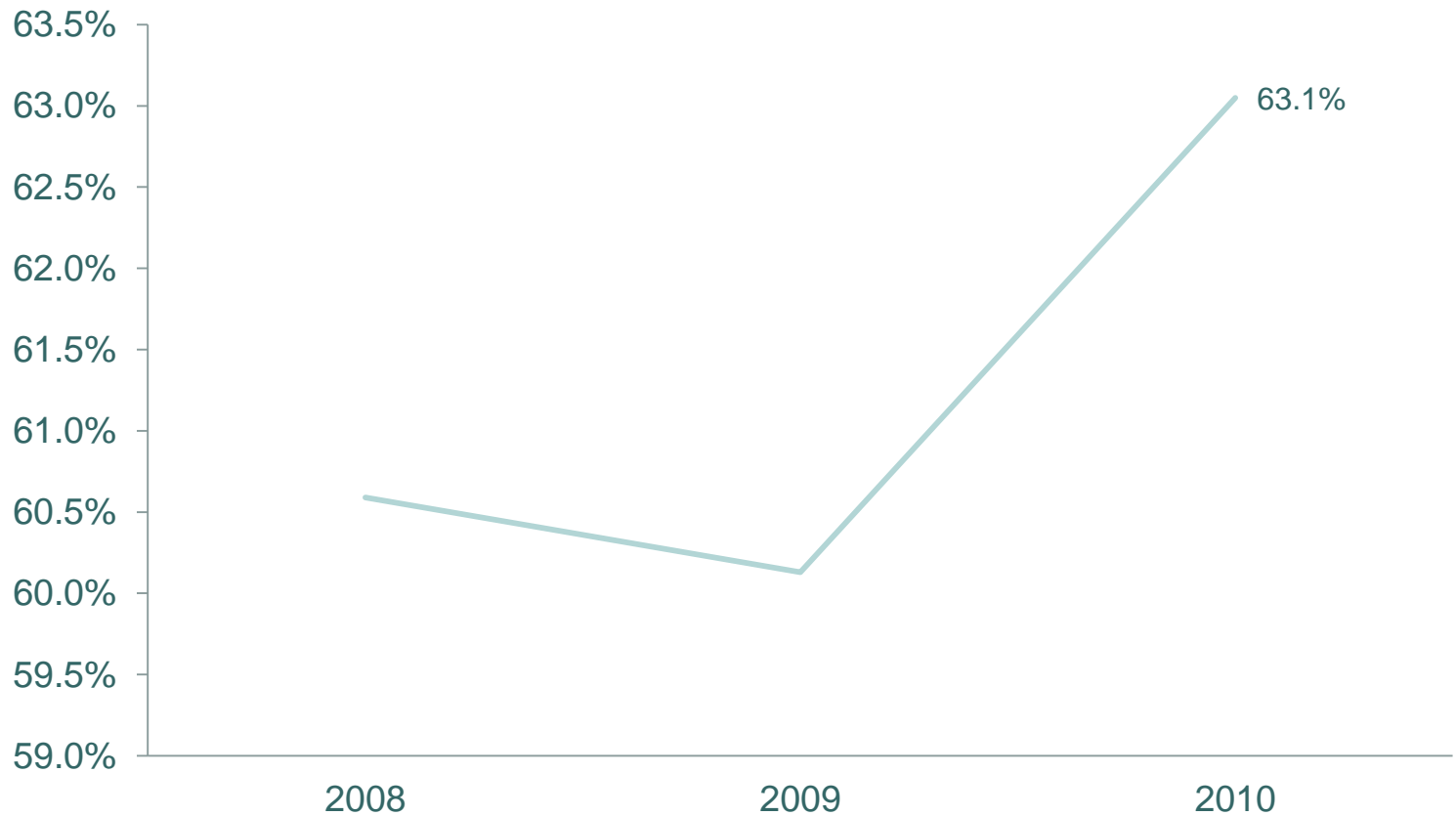


3-Year Trend for % of Two Year Olds Immunized

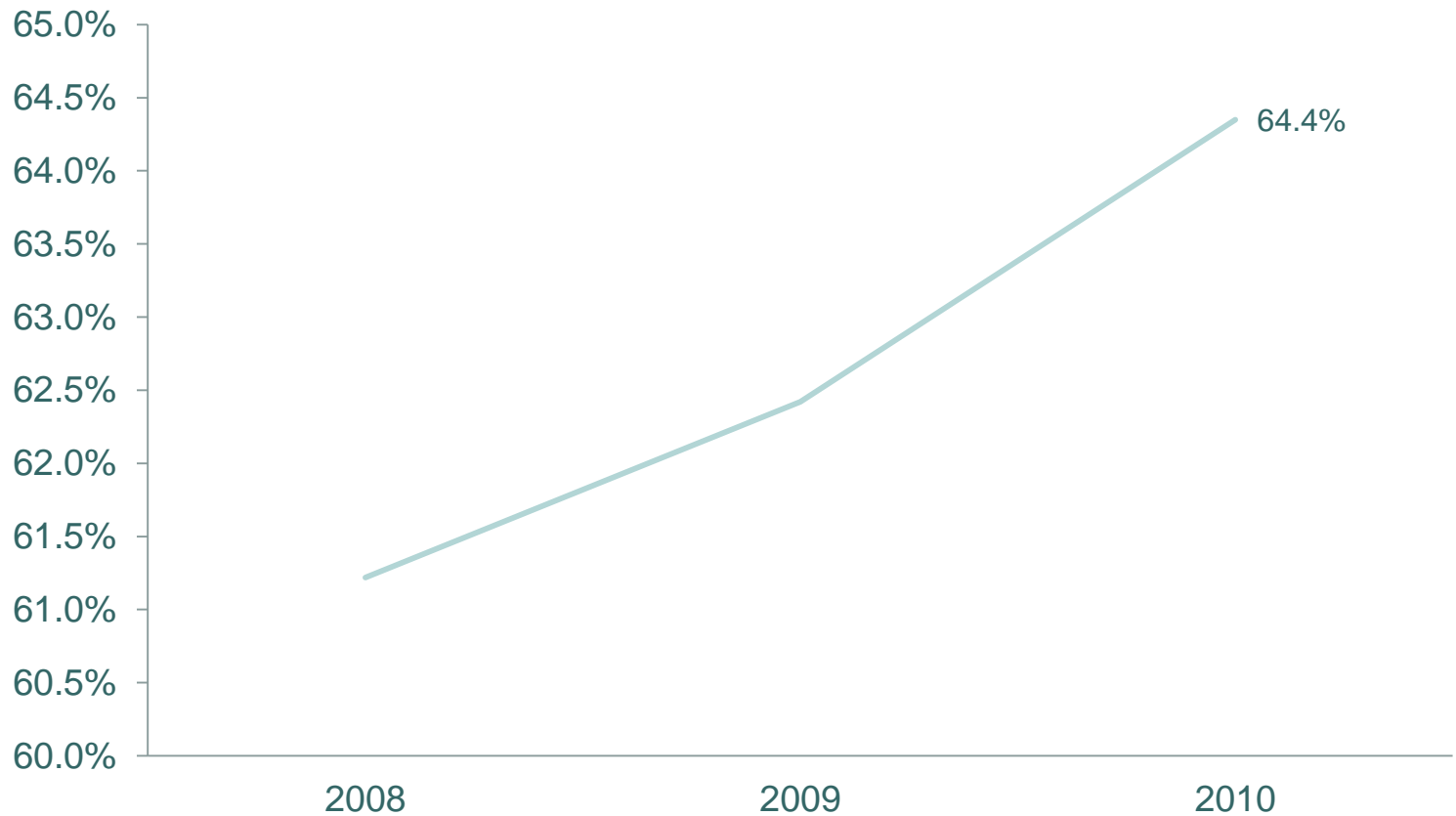




3-Year Trend for % of Women with Pap Tests
