AN OVERVIEW: MICHIGAN'S PUBLICLY FUNDED MENTAL HEALTH, SUBSTANCE ABUSE & DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES SYSTEM

This is the third webinar in a year-long series of monthly webinars hosted by Michigan Primary Care Association that support community efforts to expand integrated behavioral health and primary care.

Webinar Overview:

During this webinar you will get an overview of Michigan's publicly funded mental health, substance abuse, and developmental disabilities system. This will include the management and delivery structure of Community Mental Health Service Providers (CMHSPs), Prepaid Inpatient Health Plans (PIHPs), and substance abuse Coordinating Agencies (CAs), as well as primary funding sources and priority service populations.

Faculty:

Michael Vizena is the executive director of the Michigan Association of Community Mental Health Boards (MACMHB), the statewide association of 46 community mental health boards and affiliate provider agency members from throughout the state. Mr. Vizena has been the director of MACMHB since February, 2009. Prior to assuming his position with MACMHB, he was the executive director of Lapeer County CMH Services for 7 years and the executive director of Genesee County CMH Services for 13 years. He began his career in publicly funded mental health services working in a number of clinical and administrative positions for 14 years with the Macomb County CMH Board.

Kristie R. Schmiede, MPH, ICCS, ICADC, CPC-M has over 25 years of experience in the addiction and public health fields. Ten of those years were spent in local public health as director of addiction and clinical services that included primary care, family planning, HIV, and STDs. During that time she co-authored the County's public places tobacco use regulation. She is current Director of Prevention and Health Promotion for Genesee County Community Mental Health in Flint, Michigan, with responsibility for prevention, health and wellness services, the recovery center project, and substance abuse coordinating agency oversight. She is current President of the Michigan Association of Substance Abuse Coordinating Agencies, and current Vice President of the Michigan Certification Board for Addiction Professionals.
